Farm safety advocates are pushing hard for legislation to make quad bikes safer and they expect to see action in the next few months.

The head of the national farm safety body Farmsafe Australia, Charles Armstrong, says the current high rate of quad bike fatalities is unacceptable.

He says the agricultural sector will be lobbying hard to achieve change.

"The first target will be to ensure that we have some device fitted to prevent the huge number (of deaths). We are already around ten fatalities for 2012," he said.

"That will be goal number one and I believe we will achieve that in some form or other before the end of this year."
